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NursingInspired Student Ambassador Program

Objective: The NursingInspired Student Ambassador Program aims to empower future nurses to become advocates for nursing and representatives of the NursingInspired brand, fostering a supportive community, promoting professional growth, while increasing brand visibility.

Program Structure

1. Ambassador Roles & Responsibilities

- **Brand Promotion:** Ambassadors will actively promote *NursingInspired Rx* through social media, campus events, flyers, school newsletters, peer networks, etc.
- Content Creation: Share insights, experiences, and NursingInspired content (posts, podcasts, webinars, newsletters, etc) on personal social media platforms.
- Event Participation: Organize and participate in NursingInspired events such as webinars, workshops, seminars and set-up or breakdown at exhibitor/vendor events.
- Feedback & Insights: Provide feedback as a beta tester of NursingInspired products and services to help improve offerings for students.
- Engagement: Recruit classmates, co-workers and/or peers from science/ health-related classes interested in nursing, to enroll in the NursingInspired Rx program
- Collaboration: Seek speaking or vendor/exhibitor opportunities for NursingInspired (Back-to-School Fairs, College Fairs, Welcome Week, Career Day, Student organizations)

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Must be enrolled in school on a path toward nursing (high school student, college student, pre-nursing/pre-health, nursing assistant, LPN/LVN, ADN, BSN, ABSN or MSN).
- If not currently in school, must be working in healthcare (CNA, PCT, MA, CPhT, Home Health aide, phlebotomy, etc.) or have an anticipated start date to begin work
- Demonstrated leadership abilities and involvement in campus, work or community activities and volunteerism.
- Strong social media presence and engagement with peers or open to creating social media account(s) for the purposes of this role.
- Passionate about nursing and the nursing shortage, professional development, and the NursingInspired mission for increasing the number of black nurse representation
- Have reliable wi-fi or internet access and technology tools for the role (possession of a working desktop, laptop, tablet and/or smart phone)

3. Application Process

- Online Application: Complete an online application form detailing academic background, extracurricular activities, and interest in the ambassador program.
- Essay or Video Submission: Submit an essay or a 2-minute video explaining why you want to be a NursingInspired Ambassador and how you plan to promote the brand.
- **Interview:** Shortlisted candidates will be invited for a virtual interview.



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- **4. Program Timeline*** (2024-2025 inaugural program length *does not* include August -September)
 - Application Period: October 1 October 30
 - **Selection Announcement:** November 15
 - Program Kickoff: December 1
 - **Program Duration:** December 1 May 30

5. Benefits

- Networking: Connect with nursing professionals, educators, peers and other healthcare connections in the NursingInspired community.
- Professional Development: Gain access to exclusive webinars, workshops, and resources
- Group Mentorship: Receive mentorship alongside your future nurse peers led by a Nursing professional, leader and entrepreneur with over 10 years of experience and recognition
- Leadership Skills: Learning to stand out as a healthcare advocate and leader with in-person and virtual health-related events at your school and through social media
- Merchandise & Discounts: Ambassadors will receive NursingInspired merch and discounts on products and coaching services through your own unique referral link
- Certification: Receive a certificate of recognition upon successful completion of the program and a letter of recommendation highlighting your volunteerism

6. Ambassador Expectations

- **Commitment:** Ambassadors are expected to commit to the program for one academic year. May apply for an added year as student peer lead and NursingInspired Rx scholarship.
- Monthly Check-ins: Participate in monthly virtual check-ins with the NursingInspired team to discuss progress and upcoming activities.
- Social Media Engagement: Post at least 2-3 times per month on behalf of NursingInspired on social media platforms per brand guidelines with reposts on personal accounts
- Event Hosting & Collaboration: Organize at least one NursingInspired campus event, webinar or collaboration event with student organizations/school departments per semester
- Participation in virtual events: Chat engagement, Q&A management, technical support, moderate breakout rooms, capture key takeaways for post-event social media highlights

7. Evaluation & Feedback

- Performance Reviews: Quarterly reviews to assess the impact and effectiveness of ambassadors.
- Feedback Surveys: Regular surveys to gather insights on the program's strengths and areas for improvement.
- Recognition: Top performing ambassadors will be recognized on NursingInspired's website and social media channels.
